



TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. ABOUT AUDIRE ACADEMY OF ARTS

Audire Academy of Arts ("Audire," "the Academy," "we," "us," or "our") provides educational instruction and training in music, audio production, technology, and related creative arts. Programs may include Piano, Voice, Pro Tools, Logic Pro, Game Audio, Sound Design, Orchestral Arrangements, Music Production, workshops, courses, and other creative-arts programs offered by Audire.

2. ENROLLMENT

Enrollment is subject to availability. A student is considered enrolled only after Audire has received all required registration information and, where applicable, the required payment. Audire may limit enrollment in individual classes, programs, workshops, or sessions based on available space, equipment, instructor availability, or other operational considerations. Enrollment does not guarantee placement in a particular class, instructor, day, or time unless specifically confirmed by Audire.

3. CLASS CAPACITY & BOOKING

Audire may establish maximum enrollment limits for individual classes and sessions. Where a class is offered with a stated capacity, places are generally allocated on a first-come, first-served basis after successful registration and any required payment.

4. FEES & PAYMENTS

Program fees are communicated during registration and may vary by program. Tuition and other applicable fees are due according to the payment schedule provided by Audire. A student's place may not be considered secured until required payment has been received. Audire reserves the right to suspend participation, restrict access to classes or resources, or terminate enrollment when an outstanding balance remains unpaid. Audire may change fees for future enrollment periods, with applicable changes communicated before the affected enrollment period.

5. ATTENDANCE & ABSENCES

Students are expected to attend scheduled sessions on time and prepared to participate. Because instruction, equipment, facilities, and instructor time may be reserved specifically for a student or class, student absences do not automatically create a right to a refund, credit, make-up lesson, or fee reduction. Any make-up opportunity is subject to availability and Audire's approval.

6. CONDUCT

Students are expected to behave respectfully toward instructors, staff, other students, visitors, and Academy property. Harassment, threats, discrimination, disruptive conduct, intentional damage, theft, or misuse of equipment may result in suspension or termination of enrollment without prejudice to any other rights or remedies available to Audire.

7. EQUIPMENT & FACILITIES

Students may be permitted to use instruments, computers, software, recording equipment, studio equipment, or other Academy resources. Students must follow all safety and instructor instructions and may be responsible for damage caused by intentional misconduct, misuse, or negligence, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

8. TECHNOLOGY & SOFTWARE

Some programs may require access to computers, internet services, digital audio workstations, plug-ins, accounts, or other technology. Students are responsible for complying with applicable software licenses, account requirements, and acceptable-use rules. Audire does not guarantee compatibility with every personal device or software configuration.

9. PHOTOGRAPHY, VIDEO & RECORDING

Audire may photograph, record, or otherwise document Academy activities for administrative, educational, promotional, or archival purposes. Where consent is required, Audire will obtain the applicable consent. Parents or legal guardians may decline optional promotional use for a minor by following the Academy's stated consent process.

10. HEALTH, SAFETY & EMERGENCY

Students and parents/guardians should provide information reasonably necessary for Audire to support safe participation. Audire should be informed of relevant allergies, accessibility needs, emergency contacts, or other circumstances that may affect participation. In an emergency, Audire may contact the designated emergency contact and/or appropriate emergency services.

11. MINORS & TRANSPORTATION

For students under 18, a parent or legal guardian is responsible for registration, permissions, payment obligations, and ensuring appropriate arrival and departure arrangements. Unless Audire expressly agrees otherwise in writing, transportation to and from Academy activities is the responsibility of the parent/guardian and is not provided by Audire.

12. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY & STUDENT WORK

Students generally retain rights in original work they create, subject to third-party rights and any separate written agreement. Audire may use student work for instructional, showcase, portfolio, or promotional purposes only where appropriate consent or permission has been obtained. Students must not use copyrighted materials in a manner that violates applicable law.

13. PRIVACY

Audire will collect and use registration and program information for legitimate Academy purposes such as enrollment, scheduling, communication, payment administration, safety, and program delivery. Personal information will be handled in accordance with applicable law and the Academy's privacy practices.

14. PROGRAM CHANGES

Audire may modify schedules, instructors, locations, course content, delivery methods, equipment, or program offerings when reasonably necessary. Where a material change affects an enrolled student, Audire will make reasonable efforts to communicate the change and, where appropriate, offer an alternative arrangement.

15. LIMITATION OF RESPONSIBILITY

Audire will take reasonable measures to provide a safe and educational environment, but participation in educational and creative activities involves ordinary risks. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Audire is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to personal property brought to Academy activities, or for circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

16. TERMINATION

Audire may suspend or terminate enrollment for non-payment, serious misconduct, repeated violation of Academy policies, safety concerns, or other substantial reasons. A student or parent/guardian may withdraw subject to the Cancellation & Refund Policy.

17. GOVERNING LAW & ACCEPTANCE

These Terms & Conditions are intended to be interpreted under the laws applicable in The Bahamas, subject to any mandatory legal requirements. By registering for or participating in an Audire program, the student and, where applicable, the parent or legal guardian acknowledge that they have reviewed and agree to these Terms & Conditions and the Academy's related policies.
